

ROTATION RULES - SATURDAY ROXBURY

effective 29 June 2019

Players will contact the Coordinator by email each week if they wish to play. All positive emails will be acknowledged.

Multiples of four players will be chosen each week to play. The Coordinator will generally use the following criteria to determine who gets to play when there is not a multiple of four:

Frequency of Saturday Play
Skill Level
Date & Time of Sign Up
History of Late Cancellations

The Coordinator may or may not decide the starting courts and teams. When the Coordinator does not make this determination, the players will do so upon their arrival at the court.

The Coordinator will keep track and publish who is required to bring new balls each week.

When there are only four players players will decide partnerships after each set.

When there are eight or more players the following rules will apply:

Play will consist of a single six game set. The winning team will split up and play on the higher winning court. The losing team will split up and play on the lower losing court. When any court has completed one set, all other courts will stop play unless the teams are currently tied. If tied then a seven point tie breaker will determine the winner. If the score is within one game (e.g. 4-3) then a single game will be played followed by a seven point tie breaker if needed.
